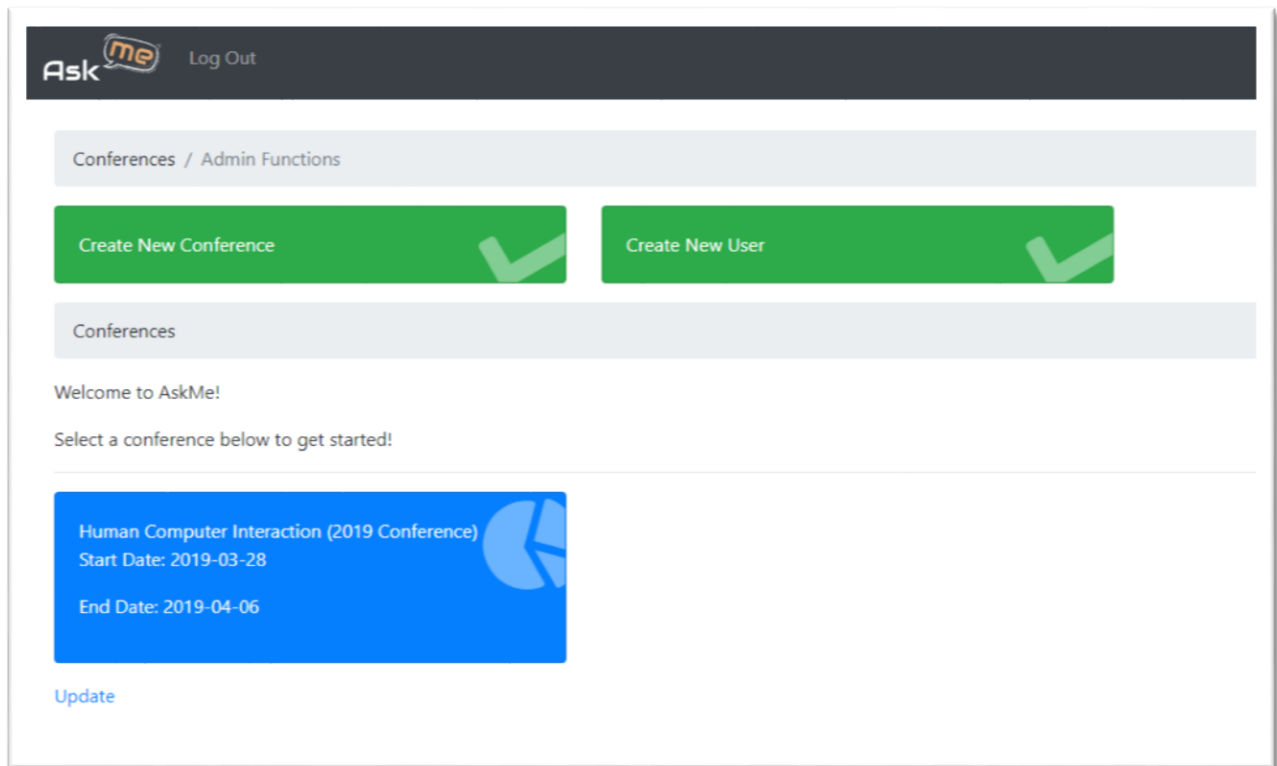

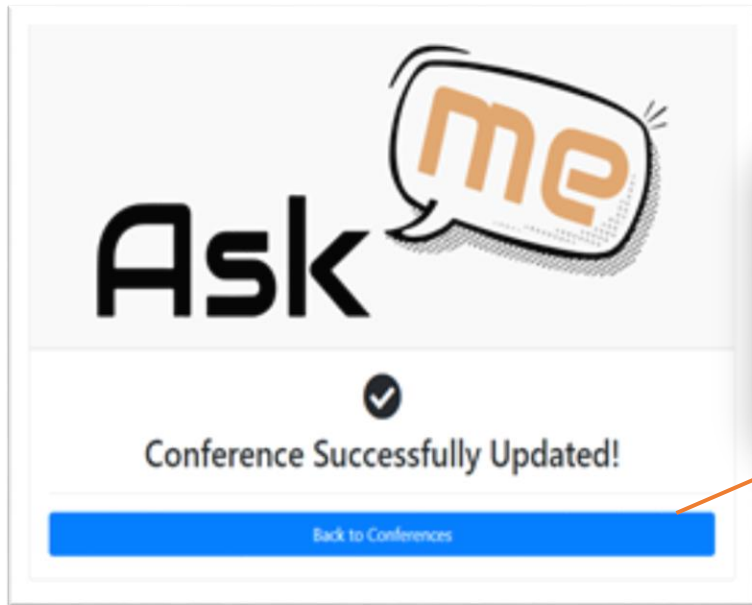

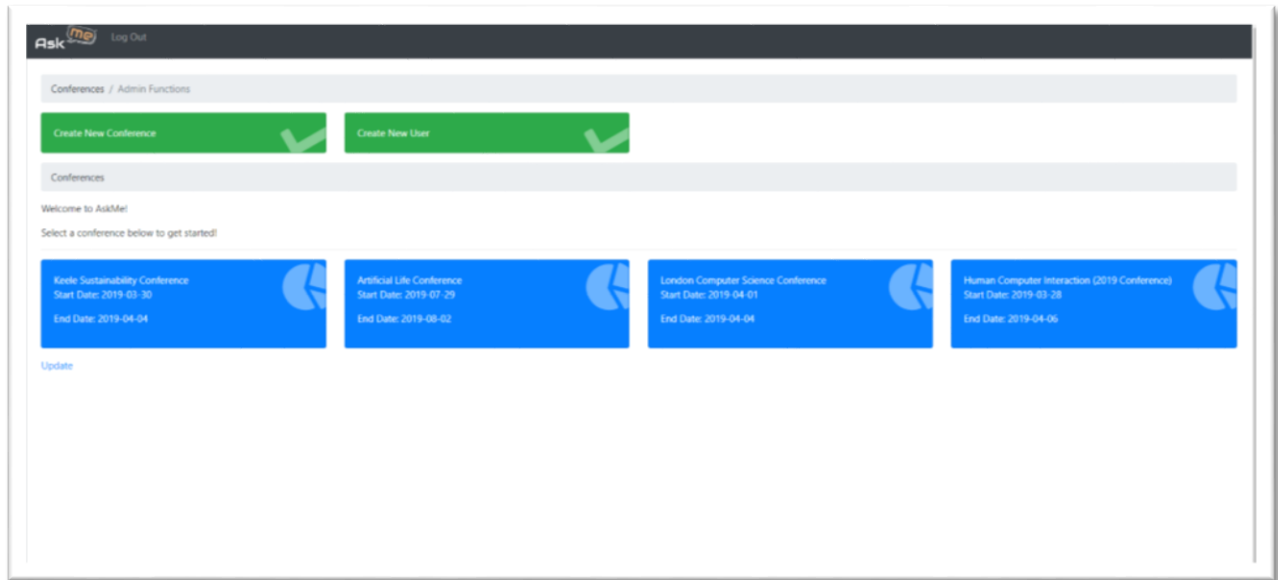

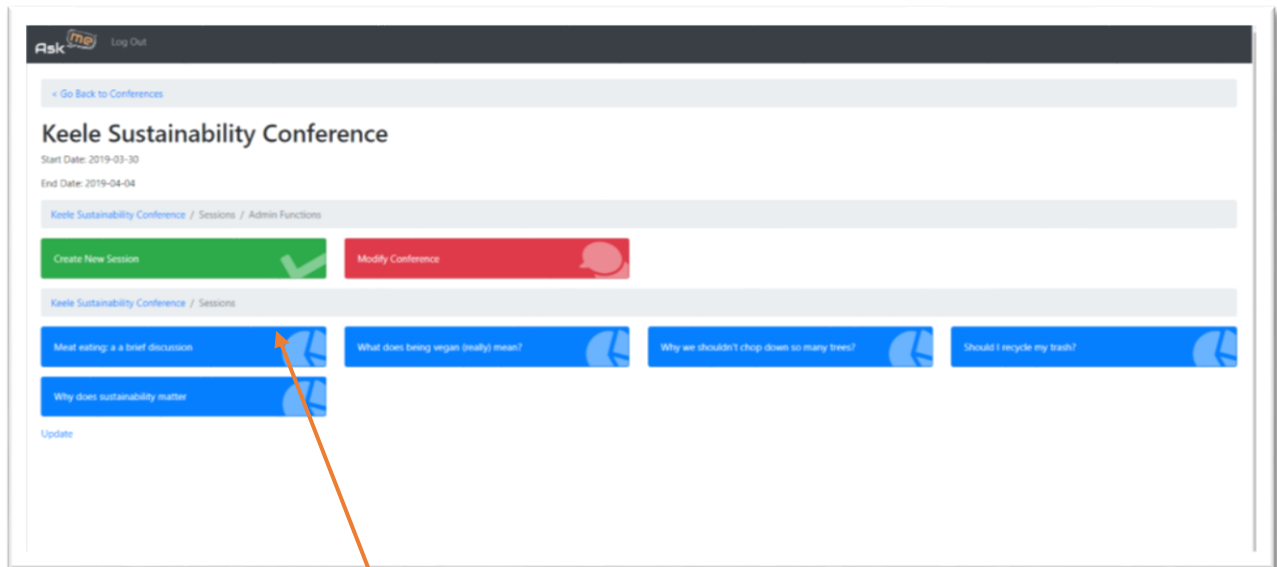

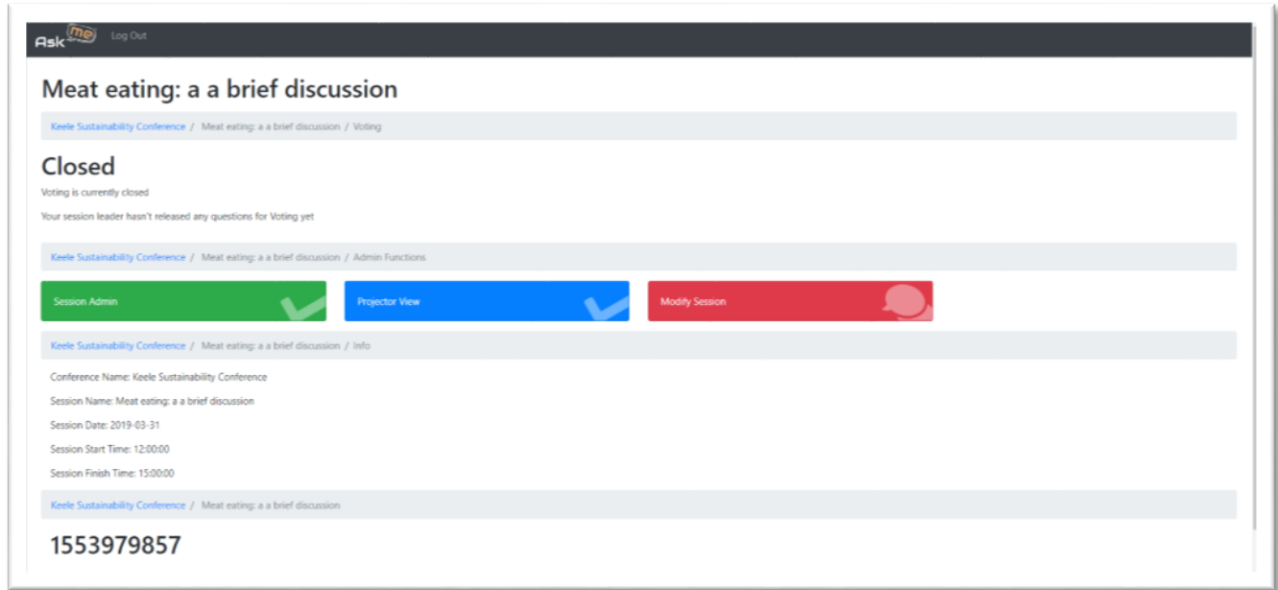

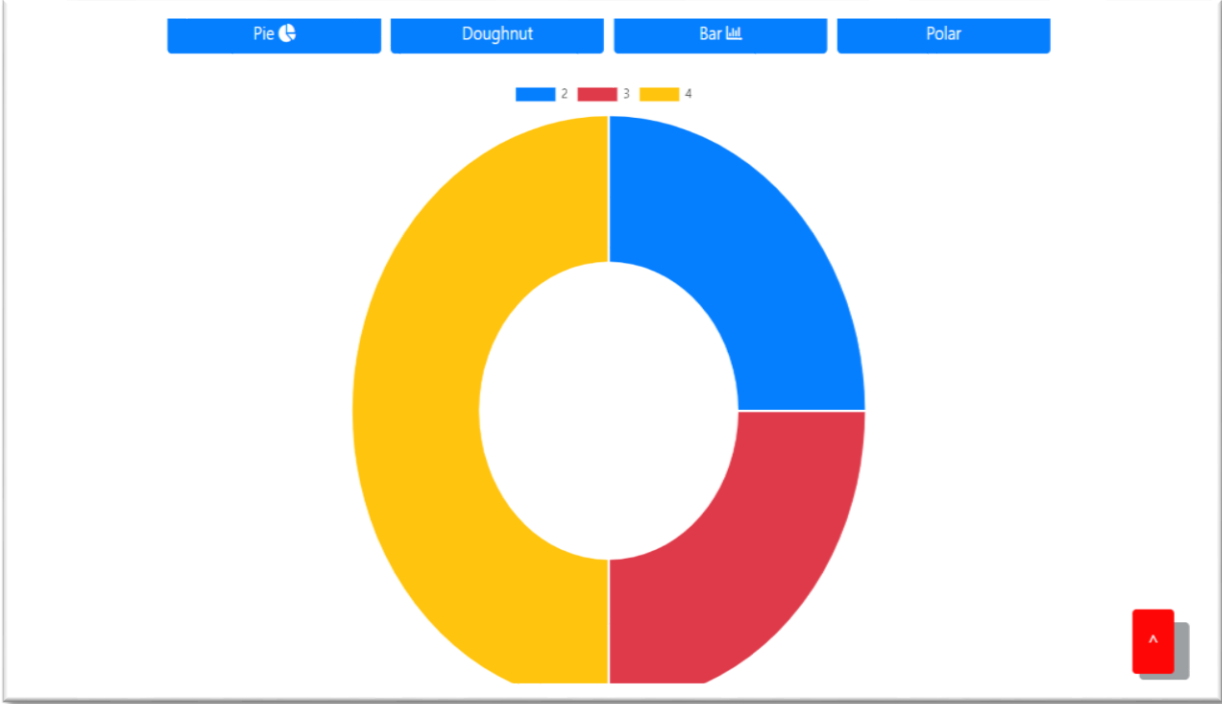

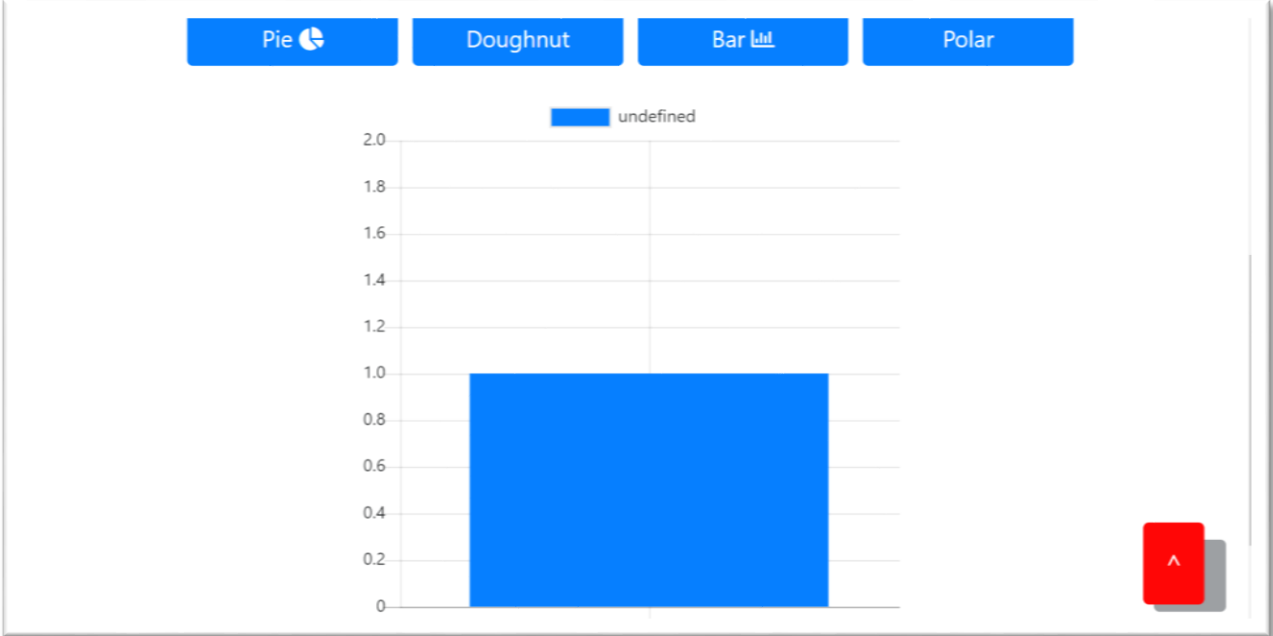

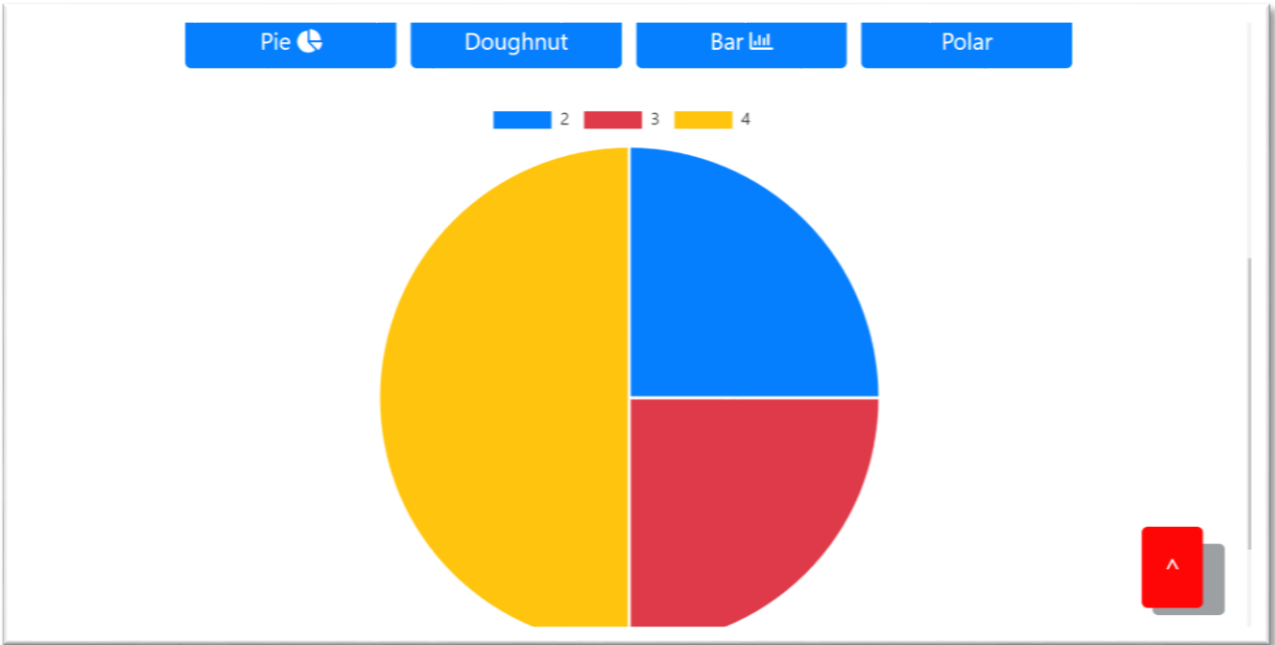
DONUT CHART

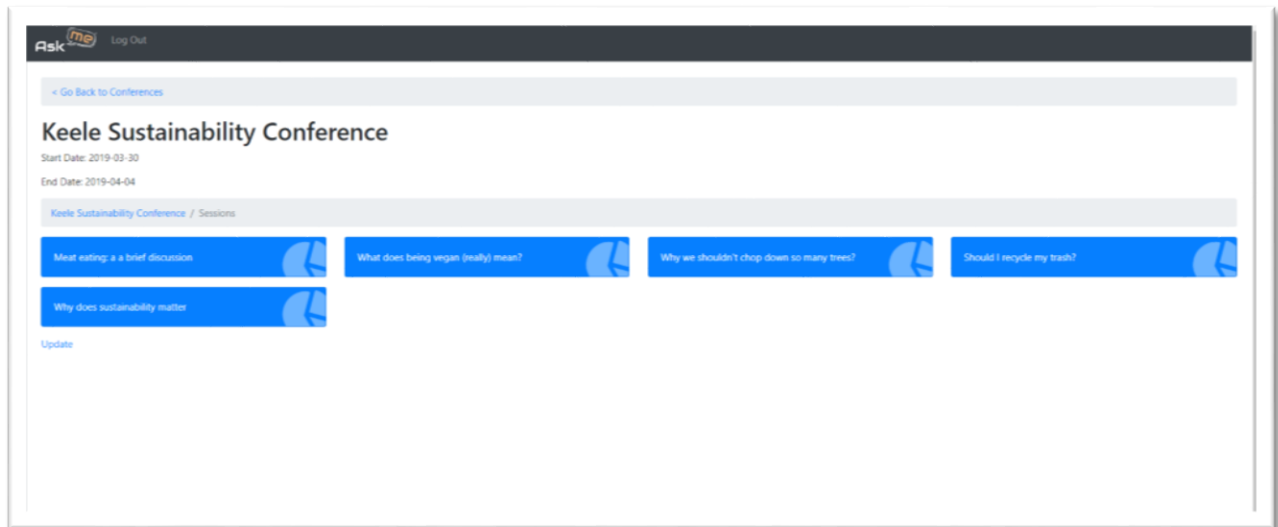

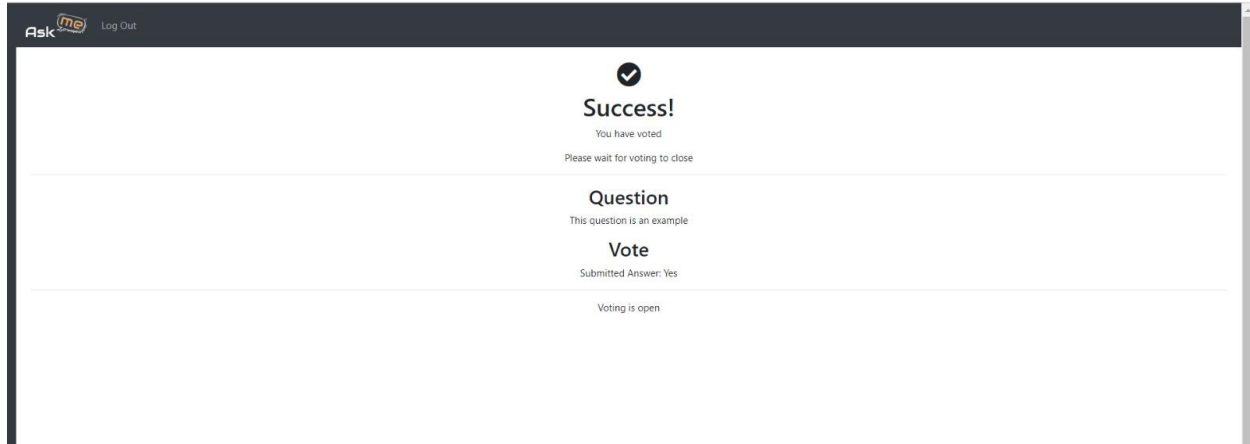

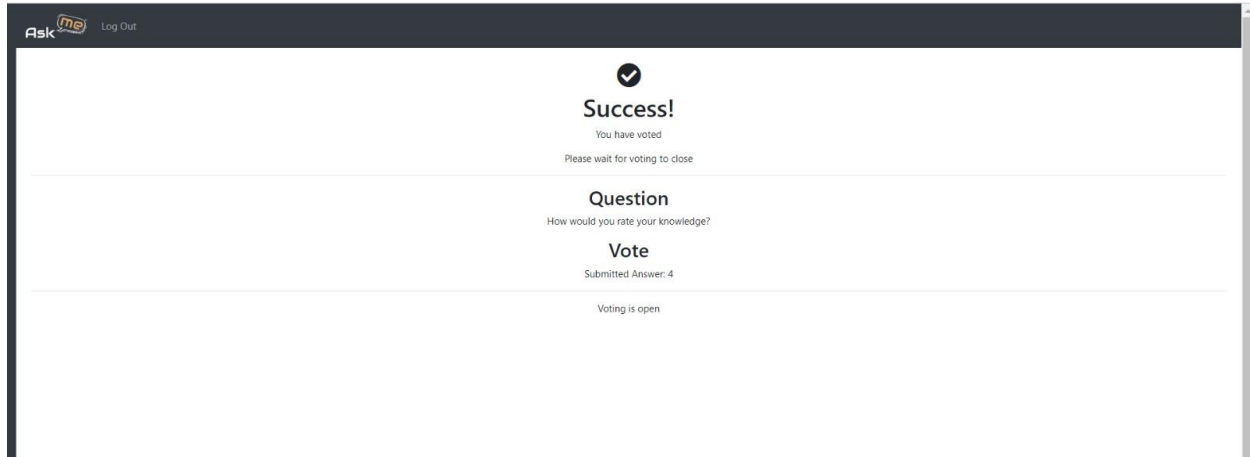
